

**Minutes of the meeting taken by the Commissioner-Cum-Secretary to Government, E&TE&T Department, Odisha regarding filling up of vacant posts of ATOs of ITIs on 5<sup>th</sup> December'2012 at 4.00 PM.**

The Commissioner-Cum-Secretary to Government, E&TE&T Department, Odisha reviewed the position of filling up of the vacant posts of ATOs of different Government ITIs / SDCs on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2012 at 4.00 PM in his Office chamber. Sri Hemant Sharma, I.A.S., Commissioner-Cum-DTE&T, Odisha and other following officers were present in the meeting.

2. Sri Ratnakar Rout, OAS (SAG), Addl. Secretary to Govt.,
3. Sri P.K.Das, OAS(S), Joint Secretary to Govt.
4. Sri N. K. Mantry, OAS, Deputy Director(Admn.) O/o DTE&T, Odisha
5. Sri A. K. Panda, Deputy Director(MPP) O/o DTE&T, Odisha.

At the outset the Commissioner-Cum-DTE&T, Odisha mentioned that, there is requirement of 1027 ATO posts for the existing Government ITIs as per NCVT norms out of which 727 ATO posts (238-Regular+489-Contractual) have been sanctioned. Of the sanctioned posts of ATOs, 497 ATO posts(100-Regular+397-Contractual) are to be filled up which have been concurred in by the Finance Department. Further there is requirement of 275 posts for the newly established 5 ITIs and 10 SDCs against which 155 posts including 90 posts of Contractual ATOs have been concurred by FD.

The following decisions were taken:

1. As per the observations of FD, 78 regular ATO posts are to be abolished in lieu of creation of 78 Contractual ATO posts with relevant designation as would be proposed by DTE&T, Odisha within 10 days.
2. The OSSC, Bhubaneswar will be requested to fill up 22 regular ATO posts for ITI, Sonapur with updated designation as would be proposed by DTE&T, Odisha within 10 days.
3. The OSSC, Bhubaneswar will be requested to fill up total 565 Contractual ATO posts (397 + 78+90) during December'12.
4. The advertisement released by DTE&T, Odisha inviting applications to fill up 335 Contractual ATO posts for different ITIs shall be cancelled in view of the decisions taken by Government to recruit the regular/Contractual ATOs through OSSC.
5. The DTE&T, Odisha will prepare the draft guidelines for recruitment of regular / Contractual ATOs of ITIs and submit the same for Government approval and onward submission to OSSC within December'2012.
6. Assessment of further requirement will be worked out by the DTE&T and submitted to Government for moving Finance Department as per observation of the F.D.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.






