Dr. C.S. Kumar, IAS, Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government Employment and Technical Education & Training Department chaired the meeting.

The agenda notes for discussion were placed before the Members. Items on the agenda raised by the members with permission of the Chair were discussed. The minutes of the meeting are as follows.

Initiating the discussion, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government Employment and Technical Education & Training Department insisted upon the Government decisions mentioned below for implementation at AICTE level regarding establishing the new Technical / Professional Institutions as well as for Extension of approval / Increase/ reduction in intake in existing courses/ Adding Course in existing programme / Closure of programme / Change of name of the Institute/ implementation of the 2nd Shift programme etc as communicated vide letter No. No. 657 dated 17.01.2012 in view of poor admission position in Professional and Technical Institutions in the State during last couple of years.

(i) The AICTE may not extend approval for increase in intake capacity in favour of any institution and in respect of any discipline also. Only introduction of new discipline may be allowed against closure of any other existing discipline of equal intake capacity keeping in view that the total intake capacity of the concerned institution will remain same.

(ii) Not to allow for introduction of additional programme in favour of any institution.

(iii) The AICTE may not grant approval further to implement/ introduce 2nd shift Diploma programme in the existing Colleges / Diploma Engineering Schools and also not to grant further extension of approval of 2nd shift to any institution.

(iv) The AICTE may not accord approval for establishment of new institution in the State without specific recommendation of the State Government.

After detailed deliberation on the basis of the above decisions and on scrutinization of the various proposals received from different intending diploma institutes, the Committee recommended as follows-

(A) Establishment of New Institutions

(i) The Committee recommended the proposals for establishment of following 8 numbers of new Government Polytechnics during the academic session 2012-13,

1. Government Polytechnic, Malkangiri
2. Government Polytechnic, Sambalpur
3. Government Polytechnic, Nawarangpur
4. Government Polytechnic, Kendrapara
5. Government Polytechnic, Kandhamal
6. Government Polytechnic, Subrnapur
7. Government Polytechnic, Bolangir
8. Government Polytechnic, Gajapati

(ii) The Committee did not recommend the proposals for establishment of following 2 numbers of new private Polytechnics during the academic session 2012-13.

1. Swami Sivananda Polytechnic Trust, Hari Hara Nagar, Aska, Gnjam
2. Vikash College of Engineering for Women, Barahaguda, Kenal Chowk, NH-6, Bargarh.

(B) Closure of the institutions

For the academic session 2012-13, no proposal for closure of existing Institute has been received in the Employment and Technical Education Department so far.

(C) Closure of the programme / Course /closure of the discipline

The Committee recommended closures of the following courses in respect of different Polytechnics of the State.

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(G) Extension of Approval

As regards extension of approval of the existing institutions, the Committee resolved that all the institutions may be recommended for extension of the approval against which no complaint / allegation regarding violation of the AICTE norms has been received.

(H) Further the Committee decided that all the proposals regarding recommendation to the AICTE which will be received later on but prior to the date line fixed by the AICTE, then Government and Affiliating body may consider for recommending to AICTE in the light of the decisions taken in respect of different categories as enumerated above.

(I) In view of maintaining quality education in Craftsman Training Scheme, it is felt by the Committee that granting approval for running CTS Courses i.e. two years / one year trades in different ITIs /ITCs may be extended in each year instead of giving permanent affiliation as per the existing practice in the line of AICTE approval being given to each diploma / degree technical institutes. The promoters will be careful in maintaining the standard of infrasture and quality of education in each year which will be verified by the Standing Committee constituted by DGE&T, Ministry of Labour, Government of India. A concrete proposal to this effect shall be send to the DGE&T through Government for consideration. (Action- DTE&T and Government)
